Dalecarlia	The name for the site of one of the Washington Aqueduct's reservoirs, as well as one of its two treatment plant facilities; located in the District of Columbia and Montgomery County, Maryland

DEIS	Draft Environmental Impact Statement
EIS	Environmental Impact Statement
EPA	Environmental Protection Agency
FFCA	Federal Facilities Compliance Agreement
FUDS	Formerly Used Defense Sites; properties typically that the federal government no longer owns, but that the Defense Department has taken responsibility to perform continuing environmental cleanup upon
McMillan	The name for the site of one of the Washington Aqueduct's reservoirs, as well as one of its two treatment plant facilities; located in the District of Columbia
Monofill	A landfill that contains only one type of material
NEPA	National Environmental Policy Act
NPDES	National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System

Spring Valley	An area of Washington, D.C. that is a Formerly Used Defense Site currently undergoing study and cleanup by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers

Washington Aqueduct	The wholesale public water utility that serves the District of Columbia, Arlington County and the Falls Church service area in Virginia. It is part of the US Army Corps of Engineers.
Wholesale Customers	The term for the direct utility purchasers of drinking water from the Washington Aqueduct, for resale to the general public; these are the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority; Arlington County, Virginia; and the City of Falls Church, Virginia
WTP	Water Treatment Plant
